For Pre-AP options, Math, Science, and Foreign Language courses, the signature of your current 8th grade subject area teacher is required. We want students to communicate with their current teachers to assure the most thoughtful placement decision.

For Pre AP Courses FRHS recommends a B or higher in the current middle school subject area, as well as agreement to the homework load, which is typically 3-6 hours per week.

For Math and Foreign Language FRHS recommends a strong C or higher in the current grade level to be promoted to the next level.
